GENERAL TRANSFER GUIDE FOR LORAIN COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE

John Carroll University welcomes inquiries from students at Lorain County Community College who wish to obtain a bachelor's degree. This guide has been designed to assist the student to choose courses which will meet current core requirements at John Carroll. The core requirements consist of specific courses in five divisions. You may choose to take these classes at LCCC or John Carroll after you have transferred. Only specific courses meet CORE requirements at John Carroll: their LCCC equivalents are listed below:

Students accepted at John Carroll University will receive official transcript evaluations after having been admitted. The credit evaluation will include a list of courses and credits which are transferable. Students should note that John Carroll uses a semester credit system.

These University core requirements are good through the summer 2015 semester. A new core curriculum will go into effect beginning the fall 2015 semester for incoming first year students. There is a limit of 64 semester hours (96 quarter hours) that may be transferred from a community college.
