### Five-Year Programs

John Carroll offers six five-year programs that provide students the opportunity to complete both the bachelor's and master's degree within five years. Programs are currently offered in the following programs: Business, Education, English, Mathematics, Nonprofit Administration, and Theology and Religious Studies. ### Dual Degree Programs

John Carroll participates in a series of dual-degree programs with Case Western Reserve University. Through these partnerships, students complete three years of full time study at John Carroll and two or three additional years of full time study at Case in order to earn an undergraduate degree at John Carroll plus an undergraduate engineering degree from Case or a graduate degree in law, nursing, or social work from Case.
