For an undergraduate student, 12 hours is considered full time for financial aid purposes per semester.

Financial aid awards are based on enrollment status (full or part-time) for each term. The most common reasons for an award to be adjusted include changes in enrollment status, which reduces the cost of attendance, not maintaining Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP), or an over-award due to the receipt of additional aid.
