



2014 - 2015 Cost of Education

The Office of Financial Aid's ability to meet your financial need is influenced by government student aid policies at the federal and state level and the total amount of funds we have available for aid each year, and the sum of all JCU students' estimated financial needs. Your financial aid award is based on the following general formula:

$$\text{Cost of Education} - \text{Family Contribution} = \text{Estimated Financial Need}$$

Your family contribution is determined by the U.S. Department of Education from the information you provided on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). The amount of financial aid awarded to a student is in part determined by the total cost of education.

Students registered for less than 12 credit hours per semester will be assessed at a per credit hour rate of \$1,055 and in most cases financial aid will be adjusted accordingly. Undergraduate Summer 2014 rate per credit hour is \$700.

Please note that the amount of financial aid awarded cannot exceed the total cost of education.
