

This scholarship program was created in 2011 with Bricker & Eckler awarding The Ohio Foundation of Independent Colleges, the prestigious Bricker & Eckler Anniversary Gift. With this endowed gift, the donors' intent is to distribute annually the fund earnings as scholarships to promising and dedicated pre-law students.

One scholarship is available for students preparing for a **legal career**. These awards are for **undergraduate study** at any OFIC college in the 2014-2015 academic year. Students must meet the criteria listed below. Awards may replace loans, but not grants.

- U. S. citizen
- Qualify for financial aid
- Enrolled full-time in an OFIC member college
- Pre-law student (applicant's intent, not necessarily major)
- Minimum 3.5 cumulative GPA
- Home residence in either Cleveland, Columbus or Cincinnati-Dayton areas
- Senior class rank for the 2014-2015 academic year
- Demonstrate strong leadership skill
- Involved in campus and/or community activities
