## Examples of Academy Projects

### **Systemic, Comprehensive Processes**

Establishing consistency and stability within current assessment practices across the entire institution; a systemic approach and well-established processes.

### **General Education/High Impact Practices**

Assessing and improving general education/core curriculum or continued expansion and improvement of these efforts.  
Integrating high-impact practices, signature assignments, and signature student performances.

### **Graduate Learning Assessment**

Designing and implementing assessment at the graduate level or aligning undergraduate and graduate learning outcomes and achieved learning.

6. What results do you want to achieve in the Academy? What is the potential for impact on the institution? On learning and teaching? On organizational culture?
7. How will your work in the Academy contribute to improvement of student learning at your institution?
