- *For assignments*, send copies of student work and rubric scores to Assessment Office (follow web instructions for **formatting spreadsheet**).
- Send the Instructor Rating Form and any record of the final performance/product to the Assessment Office as well.

USING CANVAS FOR MOST PEOPLE

- Create the Assignment in Canvas. (if applicable) You can also create an empty assignment, so you don't have to do the Rating Form on paper or by email. Just make an assignment with Submission Type "No Submission" or "On Paper."
- Link the appropriate <u>Rubric</u> to your Assignment. Use the CAPA Assignment Rubric in the "John Carroll University" account for assignments. Use the Instructor Rating Form for submitting your instructor ratings.
- Have students submit their work in Canvas. (if applicable)
- Complete rubrics in Canvas
