ACCOUNTANCY MAJORS

Advising Block Schedules for First-Year Students

Undergraduate Accountancy majors have three options:

1. Traditional Undergraduate BSBA (128 Hours)

This option should be taken by accountancy majors who are not planning to go into public accounting or who plan to attend graduate school elsewhere.

2. **BSBA/MBA (158 Hours)**

Same four-year schedule as the BSBA with MBA courses added as a fifth year of study. This program will qualify the student to sit for the CPA examination. Scholarships are available for the MBA matriculant. Applications should be made before commencing graduate coursework. This option should be considered by most majors.

3. Undergraduate BSBA (150 Hours)

This option should be considered by those students who wish to qualify for the CPA examination but do not wish to obtain a graduate degree. This requirement may be satisfied by taking any 22 additional undergraduate hours. A double major (finance, business information systems, or computer science are particularly recommended), a concentration, and/or additional accounting electives are recommended.
