April 12, 2016 Example of a Typical 4-year Progression through the International Business with Language and Culture (IBLC) Major

This program requires 120-128 hours to graduate. This includes 40-52 hours of university core (including EC 208 as QA), 6-9 additional hours of language (through 2 semesters of 300-level language courses), 46 hours of business core (including MT 130 and PS 101), and 21 hours of IB major requirements. Students who come in at the intermediate or higher level of language, who are able to test out of one or more computer classes, or who come in with AP credits in university core may, of course, have fewer specific course requirements but will still need to be sure that all requirements for graduation are met. The block schedule describes a typical 4 year progression through the IBLC major assuming no language or other credits or waivers. This is just one suggested matriculation pattern. University core classes and some business core classes can be traded between semesters and years.
