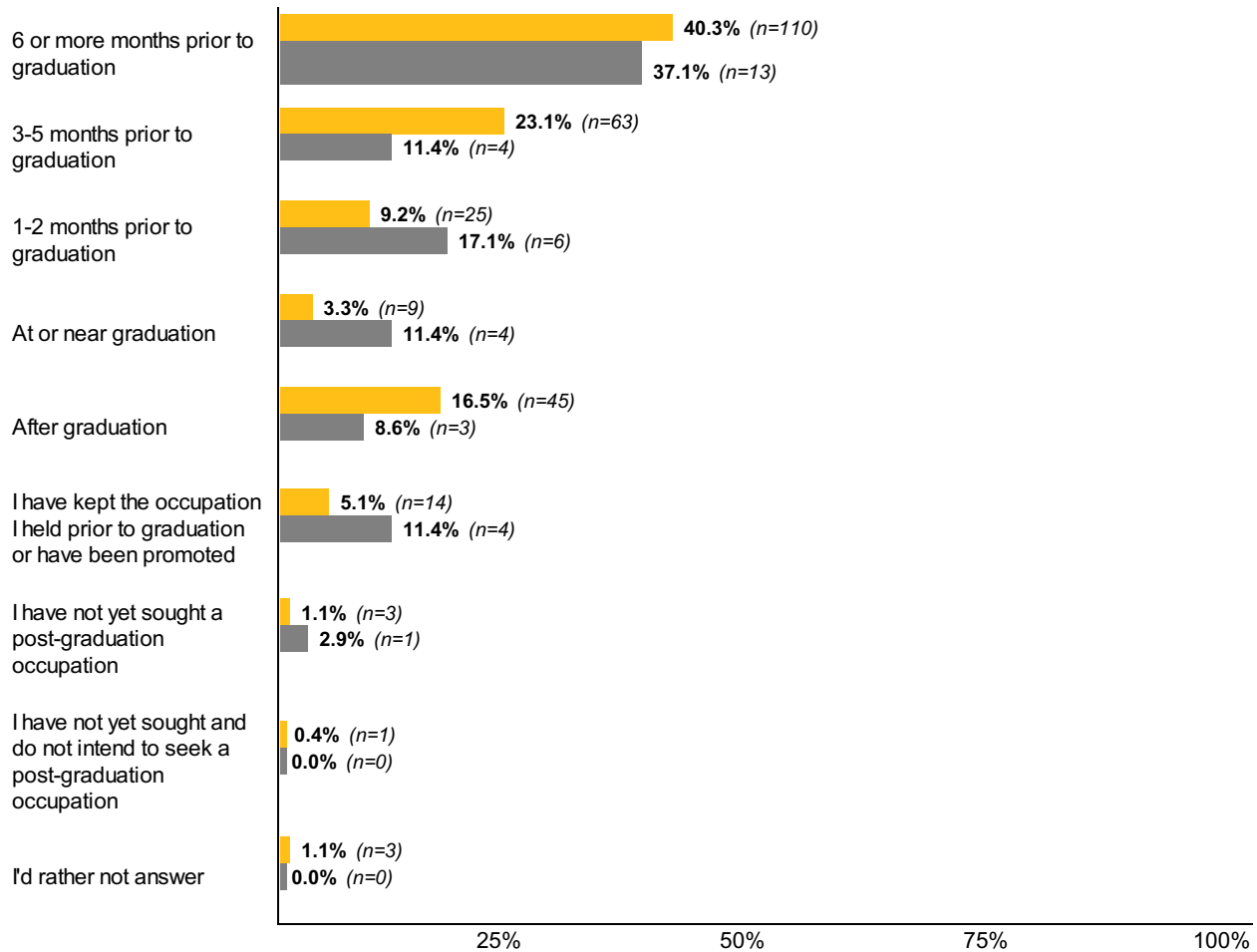

Core 3: When did you begin to pursue your primary post-graduation occupation?

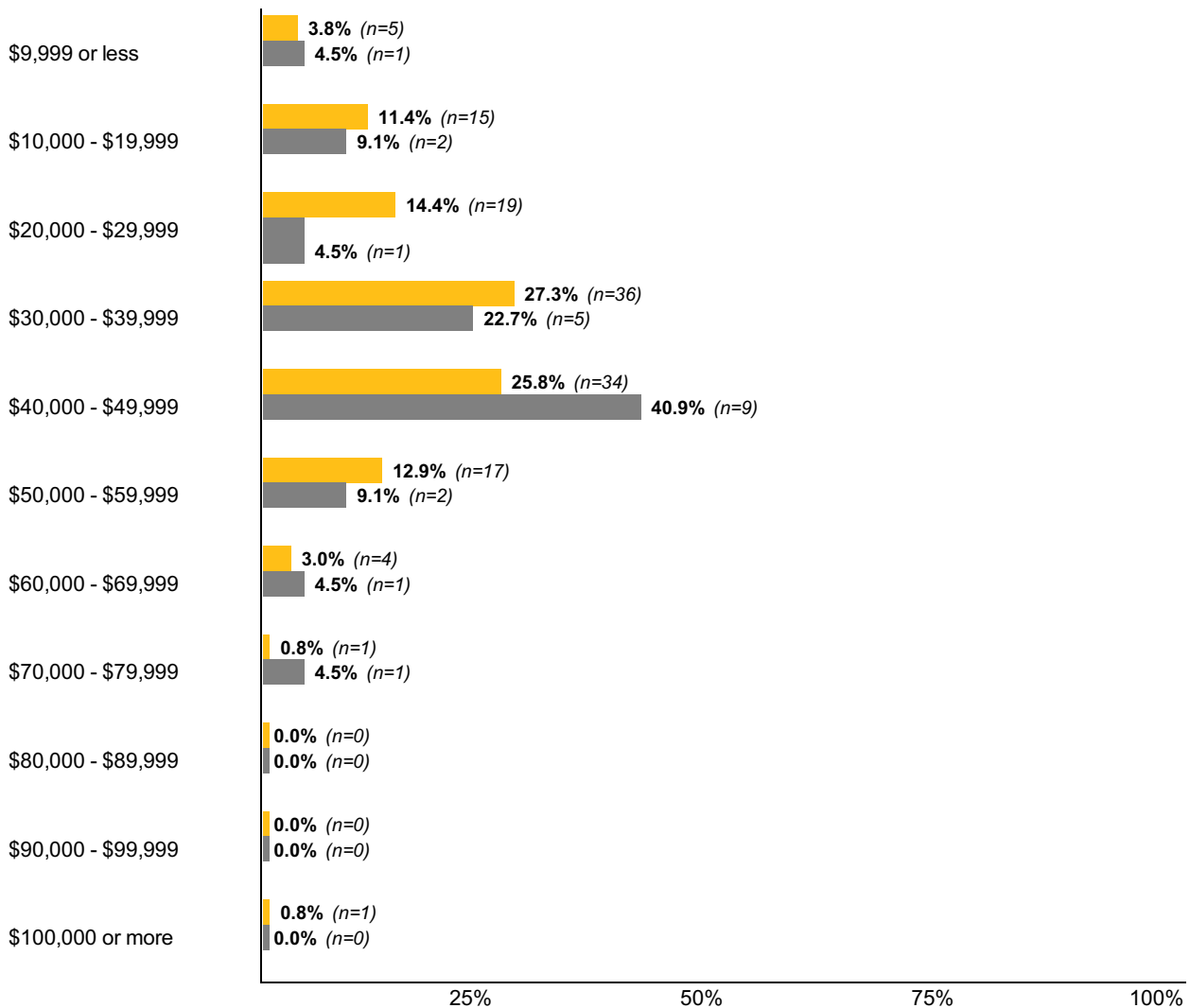

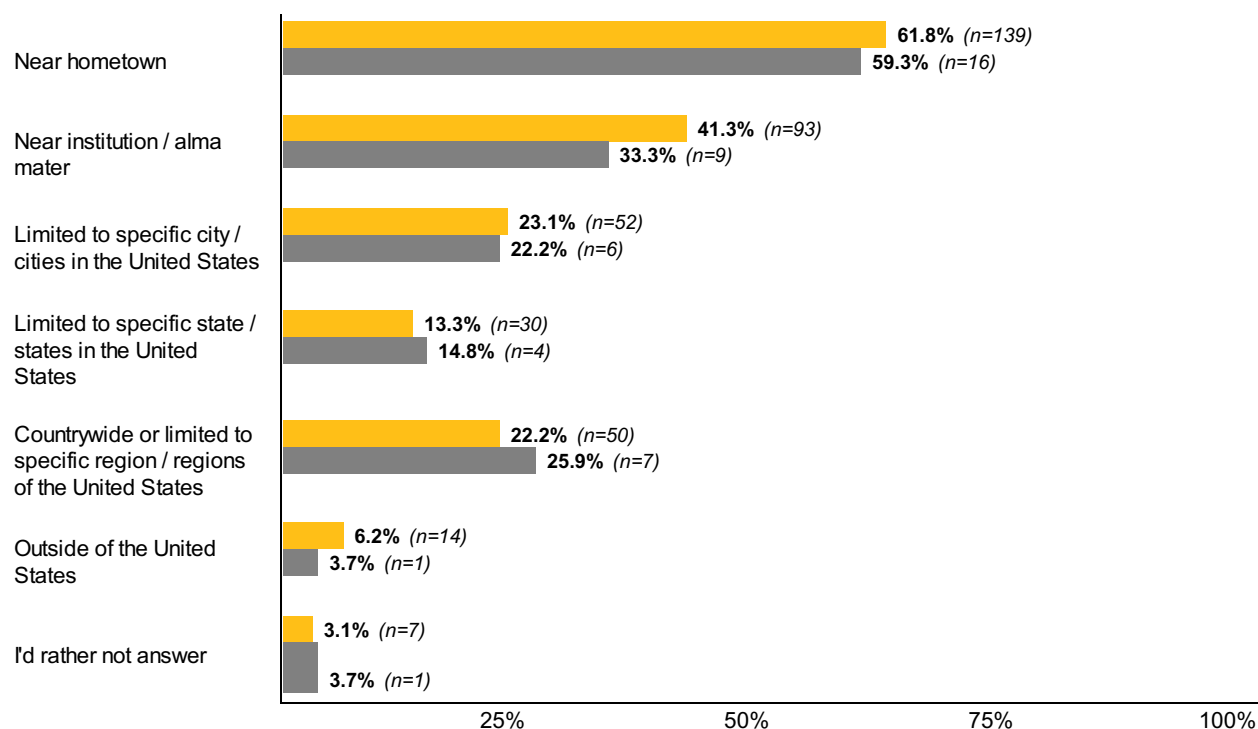

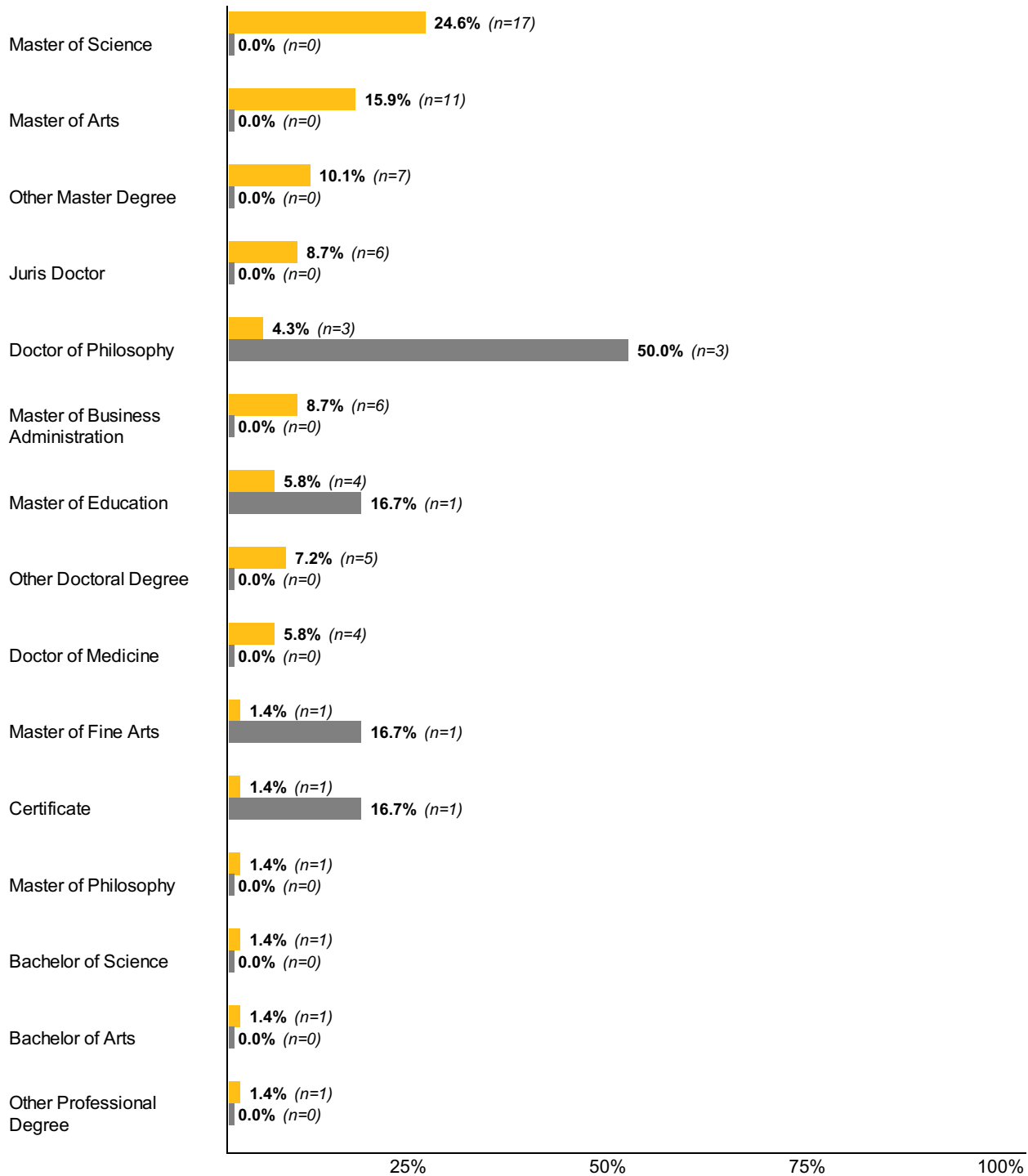

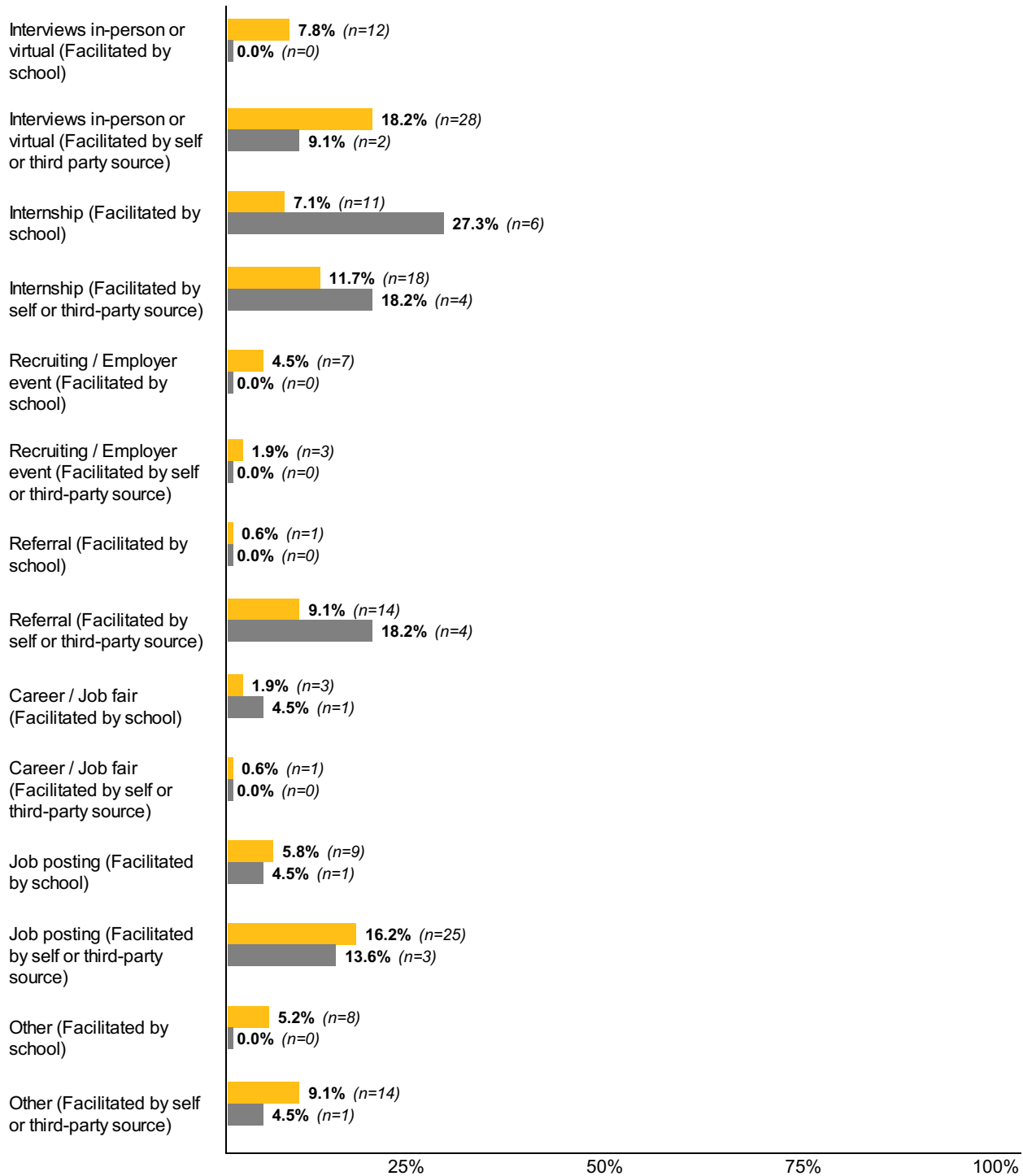

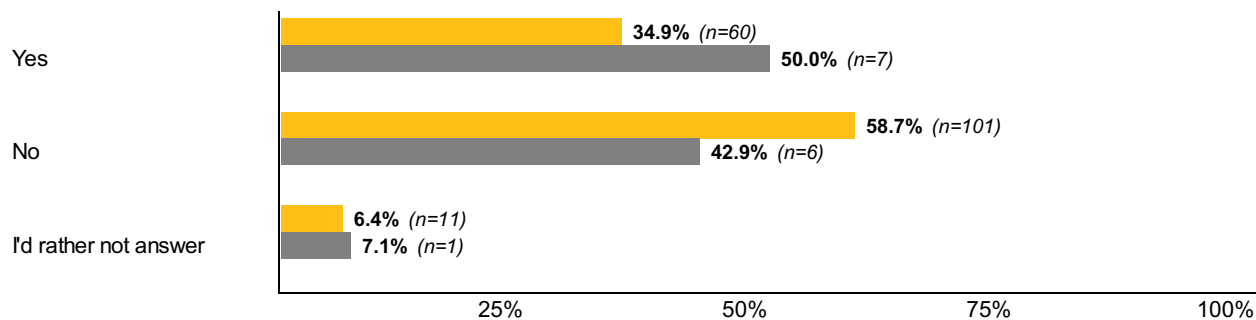

Experiential 54: Were you offered full-time employment as result of any of your internships?

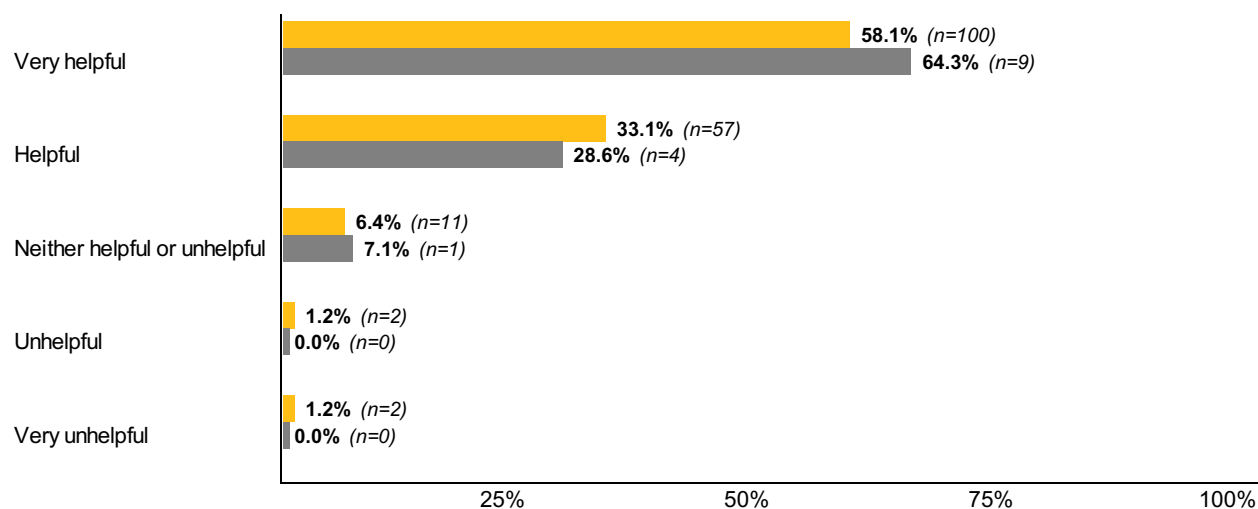
