



Charles J. Stilwell Scholarship \$3,500 2017-2018

Awarded based on outstanding performance in an internship.

John Carroll University is pleased to award two Charles J. Stilwell scholarships, each \$3500, to undergraduate students who have completed an academic internship during the 2017-2018 academic year and have been recognized by their employers as having outstanding performance.

Charles J. Stilwell became a member of the Fenn College board of trustees in 1927. Fenn College was since acquired by Cleveland State University. In 1946, he was elected chair of the board, an office that he held until 1960, when he was elected a life trustee. **The Charles J. Stilwell Scholarship** was established in the Combined Fund of the Cleveland Foundation upon his death in 1972. In May, 1975, this fund was increased substantially by a gift from the trust of Edna D. Stilwell.

Applications for the 2017-2018 scholarships must be submitted no later than April 16, 2018, to the John Carroll University Center for Career Services. Late and/or incomplete applications will not be considered. The Scholarship Selection Committee at the Center for Career Services will review all applications and notify scholarship recipients of their selection by April 30, 2018.

Eligibility Requirements:

Internship was completed by an undergraduate student in the 2017-2018 academic year (Summer 2017, Fall 2017 and Spring 2018) **and** was registered with a valid course code in Banner (for example: CE 104).
