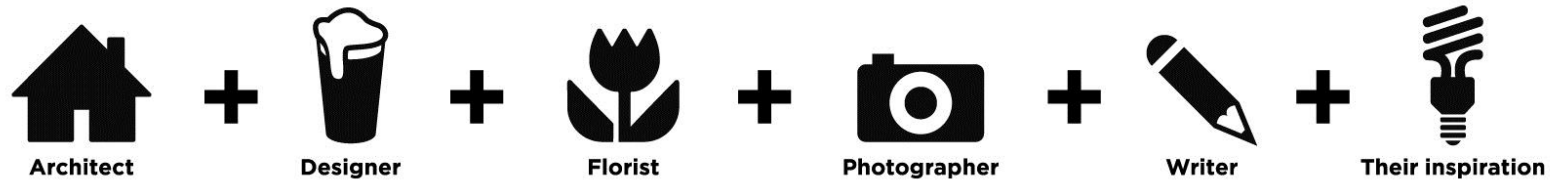

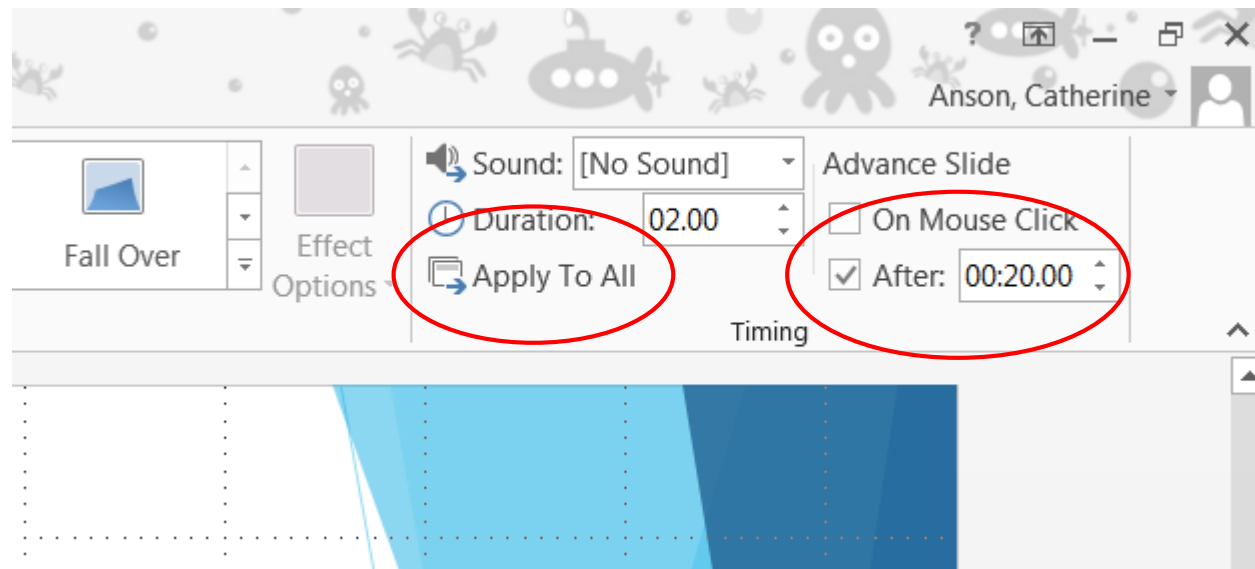
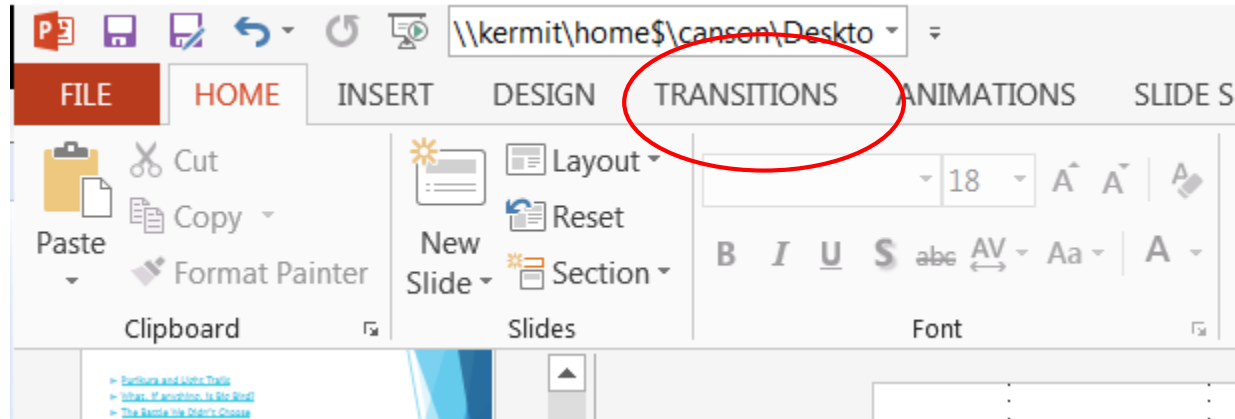

- ▶ What do you want the audience to remember?
- ▶ Powerful, relevant images
- ▶ Don't cram too much into the presentation
- ▶ Practice, practice, practice!
