
Timing of Student Departure


FIRST-YEAR COHORTS


- The largest number of students leave summer before sophomore year.

TRANSFER COHORTS


- For spring transfers, most leave the first or second summer.
- Fall transfers tend to leave after their second semester.








































Preliminary Information from Other Efforts

- 716 students completed the College Student Inventory [616 retained, 100 not retained]
- 9 variables showed statistically significant differences in scores between the retained and nonretained students

Final Thoughts

 Retention and graduation rates are strong, particularly given our selectivity vs. peers

 Groups at risk for not persisting at JCU are in line with national trends; risk factors reinforce one another

• Students who enroll elsewhere are often going home, and our incoming transfers are often coming home.
