- 1. The notes from the February 7, 2018 meeting were reviewed and approved without changes
- 2. The focus of the meeting was a discussion of the content of presentations for the Joint Meeting of the Academics, Student Affairs and Mission Committees of the Board of Directors. The purpose of the meeting is to provide an update to the Board Committees on the University Governance Committees with a particular focus on the work of UCSLE. Presentations on Student Recruitment, Retention and Success; Experiential Learning, Strategic Plan for Diversity and Inclusion and the Magis Learning Commons were outlined and a common format for the presentations was identified.
- 3. The deliverables for the Board presentations include the following: (1) that integration and collaboration across divisions is taking place to support the overall student learning experience; (2) that attention is being given to providing excellence in the student experience; and (3) that the outcomes related to the various work group projects will result in enhancing the reputation of the institution locally and regionally.
- 4. Mission Integration Committee Ed Peck provided a draft notice to the University Community regarding the selection of the theme of LEADERSHIP for campus wide programming during the 2018-19 year. Members of the UCSLE provided feedback regarding the framing of the announcement and messaging around this theme as an opportunity to collaborate and pool resources regarding campus speakers and other programs. The use of shared marketing of activities and branding using the University Learning Goals logos was also discussed. The conversation led to the need to create a web-based portal for campus programming and a common calendar for all events.
