Type of Incident(s): Burglary

Date/Time of Incident(s): Sunday, November 11th, 2018 between 3:45am and 6:20am.

Incident Description: A resident student in Dolan Hall reported that three unknown males opened a window and asked to come in because they were locked out of the building. The resident denied the men access and called JCUPD. Approximately 30 minutes later, a student in Millor Hall called JCUPD reporting that an unknown male was in her room taking items from the room. Officers responded and apprehended the suspect. Two other suspects were found in an empty room in Millor. These other two men were arrested upon discovering that they were in possession of additional stolen items. JCUPD and University Heights police officers spoke with residents in Millor and determined that two rooms were entered and items taken.

Additional Information: There were no threats made or injuries sustained during these incidents. The connection of these individuals to the University is unknown at this time, but is being investigated.

These incidents provide a reminder of the importance of keeping residence hall room doors and windows locked, not admitting unknown persons into secured residence halls and reporting suspicious activity immediately to JCUPD at 216-397-1234.

- Don't allow "tailgaters" to enter secured doors behind you, especially in the residence halls.
- Let a responsible person know where you are going, when you will return and how to contact you if you go somewhere alone outside of your normal routine.
- Use the "buddy" system with people you trust to watch out for each other's safety if you go to a party, bar or nightclub. Don't walk alone after dark off campus.
- Trust your "gut" feelings and avoid persons and situations that make you feel uncomfortable
