Integrative Core

- Natural Science Distribution Requirement: For Biology, Chemistry and Physics majors, major requirements will meet this requirement; For Integrated Social Studies majors, PS 101 meets the requirement
- Humanities Distribution Requirement: For Integrated Language Arts and Integrated Social Studies candidates, major requirements will meet this core requirement
- CAPA requirement: for Integrated Language Arts candidates, this requirement is met by the major writing requirement

Education Major

- Education courses should be taken in the sequence provided in the plan.
- ED 337 & ED 386 are co-requisites and should be taken prior to ED 427.
- ED 427/427L is taken during the pre student teaching semester. Applications for pre student teaching are submitted during the semester before a student is planning on pre student teaching.
