The Early Childhood Generalist Endorsement (i.e., to add grades 4 & 5) is offered at the undergraduate and graduate levels. It is optional and recommended for EC undergraduates. To be eligible for the endorsement through the state of Ohio, students must:

- Complete 3 courses (9 credit hrs.)
- 50 field hours approved
- Additional licensure exams.

4/5 endorsement coursework can be taken in any order after completing ED 325, and the courses can count toward undergraduate graduation hours. They are currently only offered during the summer session(s) and are fully online. There is a flat rate tuition for the endorsement coursework (at the undergraduate and graduate levels), it includes a reduction in tuition by 33%.
