

GRADUATE STUDIES COLLEGE OF ARTS & SCIENCES DESCRIPTION AND GUIDELINES FOR SALLY H. WERTHEIM EDUCATIONAL LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship recognizes an outstanding graduate student who not only demonstrates scholarship, character, and commitment to others—qualities steeped in the Jesuit mission—but who also seeks to enhance, and shows promise for improving, the educational experiences of children and youth. Candidates for the award must be a currently active teacher enrolled in a graduate degree program in education at John Carroll.

The Sally H. Wertheim Educational Leadership Scholarship commemorates Dr. Wertheim's service and leadership to the John Carroll Community. Professor, and Dean Emeritus, Dr. Wertheim also served as academic vice president during an interim period, chaired the Department of Education and Allied Studies for nine years and served as Dean of the Graduate School for thirteen years. She taught in the areas of Foundations and Multicultural Education and still teaches in the Non-Profit Administration graduate program. Her leadership extends beyond JCU into the surrounding community, where she has served on several boards in Greater Cleveland and statewide. Dr. Wertheim received her Ph.D. in the history of education from Case Western Reserve University.

<u>Requirements</u> for the award include acceptance to a degree granting, graduate education program at John Carroll University. Also required are a resume, a copy of a valid teaching license, an application, an official undergraduate transcript with a minimum grade point average of 3.0, three letters of recommendation that describe academic and professional accomplishments and community service, and a 500 word essay that demonstrates how the candidate plans to make a difference in the educational experiences of children and youth.

The selection process begins in the fall semester with the formation of a selection committee that includes the Associate Dean of Graduate Studies in the College of Arts and Sciences, a Wertheim family member, the chair of the Education and Allied Studies Department, and a department faculty member appointed by the chair. *The deadline for applications and supporting documentation is the last Friday in February*. Finalists will be contacted for a personal interview, and the award will be announced and presented during the spring semester. The scholarship must be used only for tuition (full- or part- time) and must be used within a 5-year period.

<u>The scholarship amount</u> is \$5000. The scholarship fund's principal may increase in future years through gifts made by friends inclined to continue their support.
