How to Apply

Visit **jcu.edu/graduate** to complete our free online application. Applicants must also submit official transcripts from colleges and universities previously attended. (If you are a John Carroll graduate, your transcript will be accessed automatically.)

Specific programs may have additional application requirements, such as examination scores and letters of recommendation. Visit **jcu.edu/graduate** for complete application requirements for each program.

Our Admissions Process

The Office of Graduate Studies will forward your application and pertinent information directly to the appropriate academic department for evaluation. Upon the department's recommendation, you will be notified about the admission decision.

The application process takes approximately one month from the time all required material is received by the Office of Graduate Studies.

Qualified students may take up to six credits while awaiting the admission decision (at the recommendation of the program director and the permission of the Dean.)



Financial Assistance

The Office of Graduate Studies is dedicated to helping our students finance their graduate education. The following resources are available to help you on your way to joining us.

Tuition Scholarships

Significant scholarships that reduce tuition up to 40% are available for:

- Certified/licensed teachers
- Students pursuing teacher licensure
- Students in Nonprofit Administration, School Counseling, School Psychology, and Theology and Religious Studies

These scholarships reduce our tuition to a level comparable to surrounding public universities.

Graduate Assistantships

Many departments offer graduate assistantships that provide a full tuition waiver and a stipend.

Student Loans and Grants

The University's Office of Admissions and Financial Aid offers assistance on student loans and grants.
