NEW GRADUATE CERTIFICATE PROGRAM IN SPIRITUAL WELLNESS AND COUNSELING

John Carroll University will be launching a new graduate certificate program in Spiritual Wellness and Counseling in January 2014. The program is being jointly offered by the Departments of Education and Allied Studies and Theology and Religious Studies, and is being administered by the director of the Counselor Education Program.

This certificate program is a 5 course, 15 credit, course of study targeted to professionals in the mental health, health care, and pastoral fields. The central focus is to enable mental health and health care professionals to appreciate the importance of the spiritual dimension and become conversant with the scope and practice of the most common religious and spiritual traditions. In equal measure those from a variety of religious and spiritual traditions will come to understand and appreciate the psychological dimensions of the helping process, as well as the basic principles of mental health.

Students in our masters programs in Clinical Mental Health Counseling and Theology and Religious Studies will be able to use some of the coursework toward their degree requirements. WINTER GRADUATION

The deadline for applying for Winter graduation was in July; however, if there are students who will be eligible to graduate at the end of the Fall 2013 semester you may still apply through September 30, 2013. This means all degree requirements will have been met by the end of this semester. Degrees will be conferred on January 15, 2013 and the commencement ceremony is May 19, 2014. Please note a late fee will be charged to your account.

TUITION PAYMENT OPTIONS

I want to be sure that you are aware of the various payment options for tuition available at John Carroll. The Bursar's Office does provide opportunities for payment plans, credit card payments, and automatic debit payments. PRINT FEE

Did you know that at the beginning of each semester, each student's Carroll Card is funded with \$25 specifically for printing? The printing account can only be used for printing – it is not available for vending or other services attached to the card. The \$25 can be used to obtain 500 black & white pages at 5ϕ each, 83 color pages at 30ϕ each, or any combination thereof. Once the \$25 printing fund has been expended, the system will automatically begin to deduct from the Carroll Cash balance on the card. For this reason, it is imperative that the card be activated. Without the activation, the student will not be able to print.
