Overview	John Carroll University complies with the Unemployment Compensation rules and regulations for the State of Ohio.
Eligibility	Most full-time and part-time employees are covered under the Ohio Unemployment Compensation Act.
Detail	<p>Under the provisions of this law, covered employees of the university who become totally or partially unemployed and who meet the eligibility requirements as set forth in the law may receive unemployment compensation.</p> <p>The University, as a self-insured employer, pays the full cost of any benefit paid to employees.</p> <p>The amount of the weekly benefit depends on earnings, dependents and other factors that may change.</p> <p>All former employees should contact the Ohio Bureau of Employment Services for further assistance.
