DIRECTIONS: CrossRoads Ministry is located at 1226 West Oak Street, Louisville, KY 40210 on the campus of St. William Church. From I-65, I-71 or I-64, merge onto I-64. Take I-64 west, exit at 9<sup>th</sup> Street interchange. Take 9<sup>th</sup> Street south to Oak Street (watch for sign on right to Oak St., immediately following Kentucky St). Turn west (right) onto Oak Street. Turn south (left) onto 13<sup>th</sup> Street. Turn left into alley directly behind St. William Church and park in the immediate parking lot.
