Immersion Conduct Guidelines:

Participants will live the immersion experience value of community in the following ways:

- Adhere to policies of the John Carroll University Community Standards Manual (Web link: http://sites.jcu.edu/deanofstudents/pages/community-standards/)
- Refrain from the consumption of alcohol during an immersion experience (INCLUDING students over the age of 21 or legal drinking age in respective country)
- Refrain from exclusive relationships during the immersion experience
- Refrain from the use of electronics (i.e. cell phones, iPods, iPads, etc.) during the immersion (NOTE: there may be times where a student coordinator would need to utilize a cell phone for activities related to the immersion group this is obviously appropriate)
- Demonstrate appropriate and respectful use of digital cameras, video cameras, and other recording devices during the immersion

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- Complete the post-immersion participant survey
- Participate in the 2 post-experience evenings of reflection (1 dinner and 1 retreat) organized by the Campus Ministers
- Assist your group in compiling written reflections and/or a visual presentation of your immersion
- Participate in additional activities that further reflection and engagement in the topics and issues of justice that the group faced during the experience
