

Levels of Learning Goals: Linking Institutional and Program Learning Goals



This worksheet will assist programs to identify the relationship between program-level learning goals and institutional learning goals. Begin by listing the program learning goals and then indicate the academic learning goals to which it aligns by marking with an 'X'. Remember that programs are not expected to meet *all* academic learning goals. If a cell is blank, it does not imply that the goal cannot be met by the program, but that it is not currently designed to do so.
