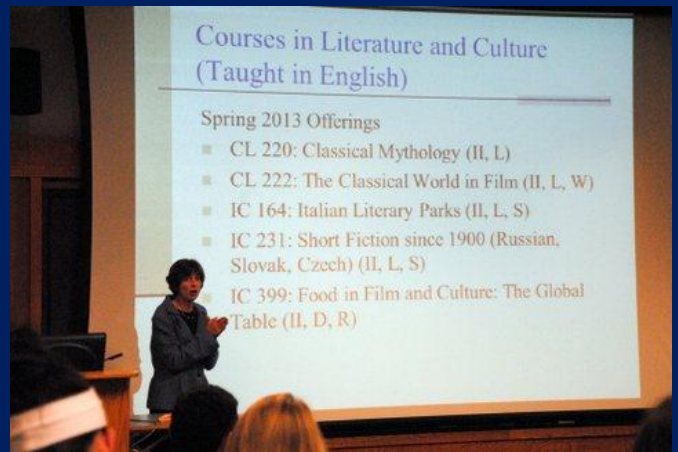

Eleven Language offerings in CMLC Dept.



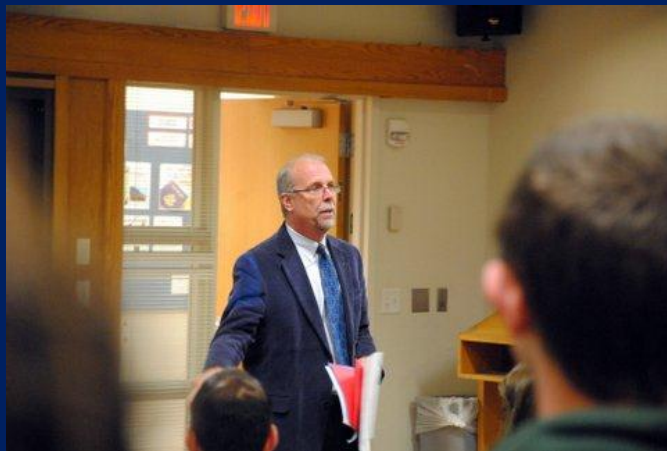

Dr. Julia Karolle-Berg (German, & Honors Program Director), describes the Honors Program, as well as numerous other opportunities for language students.

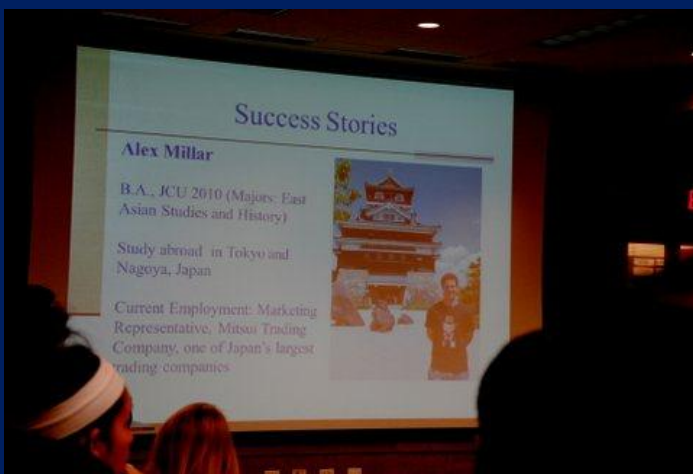

Dr. Compton-Engle described “success stories” – bios of JCU/CMLC language major grads, and where they are today.



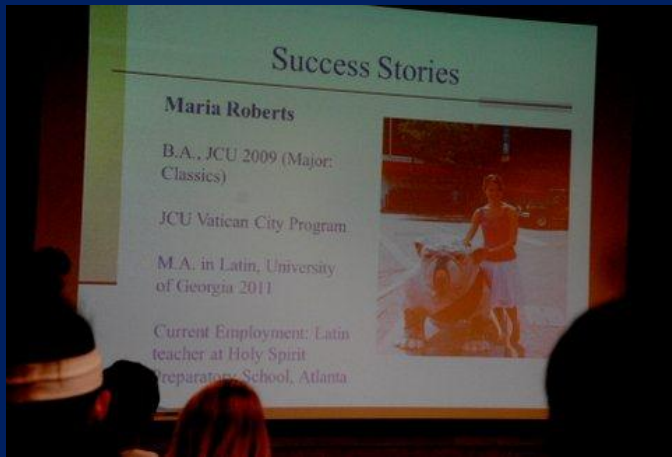

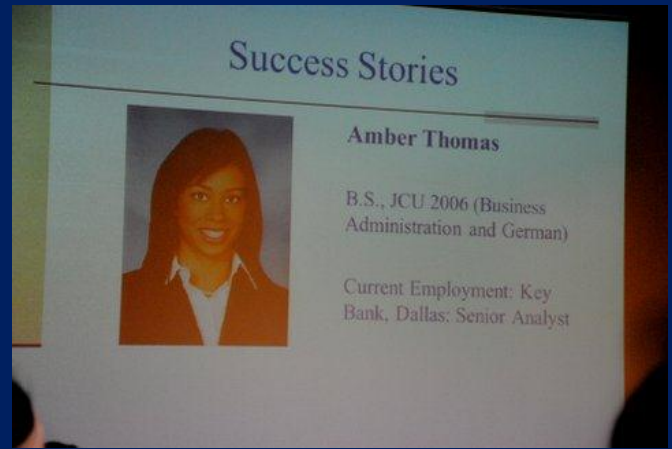

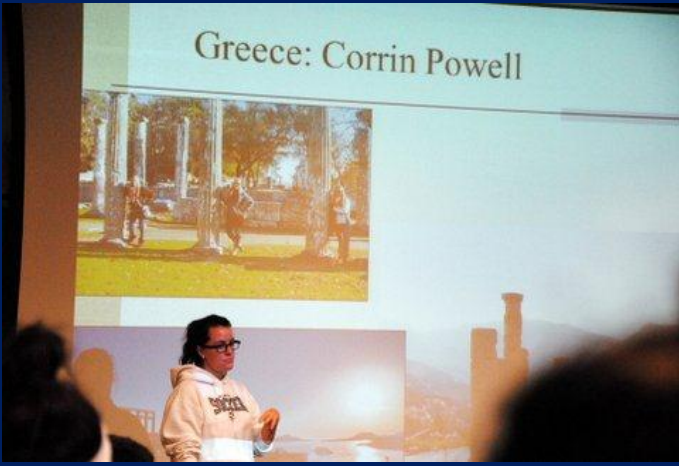
