Where is Tepoztlán?

Tepoztlán is located in the northern part of the state of Morelos, México. It is 74 km. from México City and 17 km. from Cuernavaca. Tepoztlán was proclaimed a National Park of the Tepozteco by the Mexican national government, thus, making Tepoztlán one of the fifteen Pueblos Mágicos of México.

What can I do in Tepoztlán? You can hike beautiful mountains and swim in cool refreshing streams. You can shop in open-air markets or "tianguis," enjoy exquisite meals in international cafes or restaurants, or simply relax at a spa and enjoy a traditional pre-Hispanic sauna or "Temazcal." You can visit the surrounding villages or historical sites, learn Nahuatl, the language of the Tepoztecos, and climb Tepozteco to the pyramid of the ancient gods for a view of the majestic landscape of the "Sacred" Valley.
