- 2. Attach any **program information**, and, if available, your **letter of acceptance**, to your essay.
- 3. Ask your major advisor for a <u>letter of recommendation</u>. He or she can give it to you directly to include with your application materials, or the advisor may give the letter directly to Mrs. Bailey (see below).
