

LEADERSHIP SCHOLARS PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

(for students starting in Fall 2018 and earlier)

Freshman year

FALL

- Participate in a Tier I co-curricular leadership formation program
- Write personal bio, leadership philosophy, and resume (pre-arrival)
- Take common one-credit LP 101 and one-credit LP 102 courses with other Leadership Scholars

SPRING

- Participate in a Tier II co-curricular leadership formation program
- Take common three-credit CO 125 course with other Leadership Scholars

Sophomore year

FALL

- Update your personal bio, leadership philosophy, and resume (pre-arrival)
- Serve as a SWAT Leader and Living the Mission Day student leader during Streak Week in August prior to the fall semester
- Participate in a Tier III co-curricular leadership formation program

SPRING

- Participate in a Tier IV co-curricular leadership formation program
- Take an approved course and compose a reflection that shows how the course material contributed to your leadership competence

Junior year

FALL

- Update your personal bio, leadership philosophy, and resume (pre-arrival)
- Take the one-credit LP 340 course (or in spring)
- Engage in on- and off-campus leadership opportunities, internships, etc. (encouraged)

SPRING

- Compose a reflection on how one of your out-of-class experiences has contributed to your development as a leader.
- Take the one-credit LP 340 course (or in fall)
- Engage in on- and off-campus leadership opportunities, internships, etc. (encouraged)

Senior Year

FALL

- Update resume and leadership philosophy (pre-arrival)
- Engage in on- and off-campus leadership opportunities, internships, etc. (encouraged)

SPRING

- Take the one-credit course LP 403: Leadership Evaluation (replaces the old LP 440 course, starting in Spring 2020)
- Complete Senior Leadership Project paper
- Present Senior Leadership Project at the Celebration of Scholarship Poster Session
- Complete final resume
