Population and Public Health Minor
Course Requirements
For students declaring the PPH minor after January 1, 2014

To prepare students for graduate school or work in areas related to population and public health, as well as to prepare educated citizens, John Carroll University's minor is composed of four parts: (1) 10 credit hours in basic prerequisite courses that create a foundation for later courses and which may be taken for JCU core credit in Divisions III and IV; (2) 19-20 credit hours in courses introducing students to the major areas of public health; (3) 3 credit hours in an elective course; and (4) 4 credit hours in a capstone course which combines a supervised internship and seminar.

- **Prerequisite courses** (10 credit hours)
 - Biology:** BL112/BL112L with a grade of B *or* better *or* BL156 / BL158
 - Statistics:** MT122, MT228, MT 229, *or* EC208 with a grade of C or better
 - Social and behavioral science:** SC101 *or* SC245

- **Major areas of population and public health** (one course in each category, totaling 19-20 credit hours)
 - Introduction to Population and Public Health** SC273
 - Current Issues in Population and Public Health** AR273 (1 credit hour required; may be repeated in later semesters for up to 3 credits)
 - Epidemiology** BL240
 - Environmental studies:** BL109/109L, SC292, SC380 *or* PO361
 - Social & behavioral health:** BL260, SC275, SC285, SC315, SC343, SC370, SC385, *or* PS226
 - Policy studies:** PO204 , PO309, *or* PO337
 - Global health:** One 3-credit course not taken to fulfill other PPH requirements from AR275, BL260 *or* SC370

- **Elective course** (3 credit hours)
 - One 3-credit course not taken to fulfill other PPH requirements from BL260, BL310/310L, BL410, CO455, PE200, PL316, PO203, PO204, PO309, PO324, PS226, SC275, SC285, SC315, SC330, SC 343, SC370, or SC385

- **Capstone internship & seminar** (4 credit hours)
