On Sunday, Sept. 4, 2016, an act of vandalism occurred in the North Stairwell of Pacelli Hall. An individual or individuals wrote in red permanent marker profanity vandalizing the wall. This occurred sometime the morning of Sept. 4, 2016 before 10:00am.

Any information that may be of importance to identifying the individuals responsible will help prevent damages from these acts being distributed among the building's residents. As stated in your housing contract, damages that occur to public areas (e.g. restrooms, lounges, study rooms, etc.) that are not attributable or chargeable to a specific individual or group shall be equally shared by the residents of the living area where those damages occur.

As a Jesuit institution, the value of community responsibility and care are of high priority as we work to create a living environment that is conducive to academic success. We hope that together as a community we can work to create a vibrant living experience for you and help resolve this situation.

This notice is sent with coordination of the Vandalism Response Protocol. In response, a quick repair/removal concerning the vandalized area took place. In addition, a visual posting will take place at this location in the near future.
