The Work Force will be responsible for the preparation of the residence halls for summer conferences and events as well as Fall opening. They will work in conjunction with the Maintenance, Housekeeping, and Residence Life staffs toward this shared goal.

General Duties:

- Move residence hall furnishings into appropriate rooms
- Inspect and assess room furnishings
- Conduct furniture inventories
- Assemble beds and other furniture
- Perform office moves throughout campus
- Serve night and weekend on-call rotation for Facilities emergencies for Summer Housing, conferences, and campus events

Hours:

Mon – Fri. 7 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. (Some Weekends)

Qualifications:

- Some heavy lifting is required. Over 50 lbs.
- Ability to work well with others as a team
- Some weekend work may be required
- Attendance is mandatory from 5/8-6/7 and 8/15-8/26.
- Applicant must be enrolled as a full-time JCU student for the 17/18 academic year.

Benefits:

- Free double room in Summer Housing with laundry, internet service, and cable. Housing benefit is only
 available to those working full time. Changing of availability below full time will result in loss of housing
 benefit.
- \$8.75 per hour
