Staff Council statement re: DEI

- Feedback form: Inquiring about a Staff Council response to the Carroll News controversy
- Executive Board: rather than respond to the Carroll News, the student community and the world in general, Staff Council would issue a position statement
- Synopsis of controversy provided by Dan Fotoples, Caragh Vasko and Salo Rodezno
 - Mentioned the Vice President Student Affairs letter to students, lacking response from the President
- <Full Staff Council given time to read draft of statement>
- Executive Board relied upon the Staff Council Constitution in drafting it
 - James Burrows: Good start for these issues
 - Mike Nicholson: How will it be delivered?
 - Send two simultaneous emails one to the staff community (also posted on Staff Council webpage) and one to the Senior Leadership Team (also shared with faculty/Faculty Council and Student Union)
 - Faculty Council is also crafting a response
 - Dan Fotoples: Centralize University mission statement
 - Caragh Vasko: Who is this intended for? Because if it is for students, this talks a lot about things relevant only to staff
 - Trent Maverick: Statement is very vague. Why?
 - Balancing of staff viewpoints with statement, since we represent all of our colleagues
 - Language: respect v. support (refer to Staff Council founding documents)
 - <discussion ensues>
 - Eric Eickhoff: Rewrite of statement forthcoming
 - Katie Jansen: use of the phrase "moments like these;" for folks not aware of campus situation, will this fall flat?
 - Melanie Moss: If you put a name and event to this, it holds more gravity
 - <Salo Rodezno reads statement by President Johnson on the Tree of Life murders>
 - <discussion ensues regarding specificity of response>
 - Eric does not bring the statement draft up for a vote, reviews suggested edits;
 Executive Board will meet directly after meeting to make changes
 - Brendan Dolan: Full Council could vote on giving the Executive Board the power to make changes to the statement, as discussed, and distribute

- <discussion about whether President Johnson will actually make his own statement>
- Motion to allow Executive Board to make changes, approve, and distribute; motion passed
- Amy Zucca: What about disseminating to the Carroll News? <generally supported>
