Privacy

Sexual harassment, interpersonal violence, and retaliation are typically private and sensitive matters. Resources for safety and support offer different levels of privacy to those seeking assistance:

- ◆ **Confidential**—Confidential resources can generally speak with you about your experience without disclosing it to anyone else. These resources will only forward your report in rare instances (such as where there is immediate danger to a person or to the community).
- ◆ **Private**—Private resources must tell the Title IX Office that an incident was reported, but can generally keep your identity private while you consider your options.
- ◆ **Non-confidential**—Other resources can provide you with information about safety and support, but must report the matter to the Title IX Office. With the exception of Confidential and Private resources, all JCU employees are mandatory reporters.

Emergency Assistance

Local and campus law enforcement officers are available 24/7 to respond to emergencies and concerns about physical safety.

Law enforcement officers can also provide information about filing a criminal complaint, which is separate from the University Title IX process.
