Nina Frankel, a Holocaust survivor, was born in a small town in Poland in 1926. She is the sole survivor of her family, having survived several labor camps, a ghetto, being buried alive in a mass grave, a concentration camp, four months of hiding in a bunker at a Christian friend's house, and 11 months of hiding in another small bunker during the Holocaust. Mrs. Frankel immigrated to the United States in 1949. She shares her traumatic Holocaust story and experience with students of various ages.
