- 1. Participants are not to leave campus under any circumstances once classes begin each day without the permission of the Director.
- 2. Class attendance is mandatory and participants are required to complete their homework.
- 3. Participants are not to have visitors on campus at any time.
- 4. Alcohol consumption, smoking, and drug use (excepting medications listed on the Student Health Form) are forbidden at all times during the program.
- 5. Any damage to college property will be paid for by the participant(s) responsible.
- 6. University libraries and computer labs are provided as a privilege of the program.
- 7. Participants are expected to treat instructors, visitors, counselors and peers with courtesy and respect at all times.
- 8. We prefer that students be dropped off for the program. However, any participant who requires a car must turn the keys over to the Directors in the morning before classes begin. Under no circumstances is a participant to drive off campus with others; nor is a participant allowed to ride in a car with anyone not on the staff of the Young Writers Workshop. Participants, if driving themselves, will have their keys returned to them at the end of the evening's programs.
